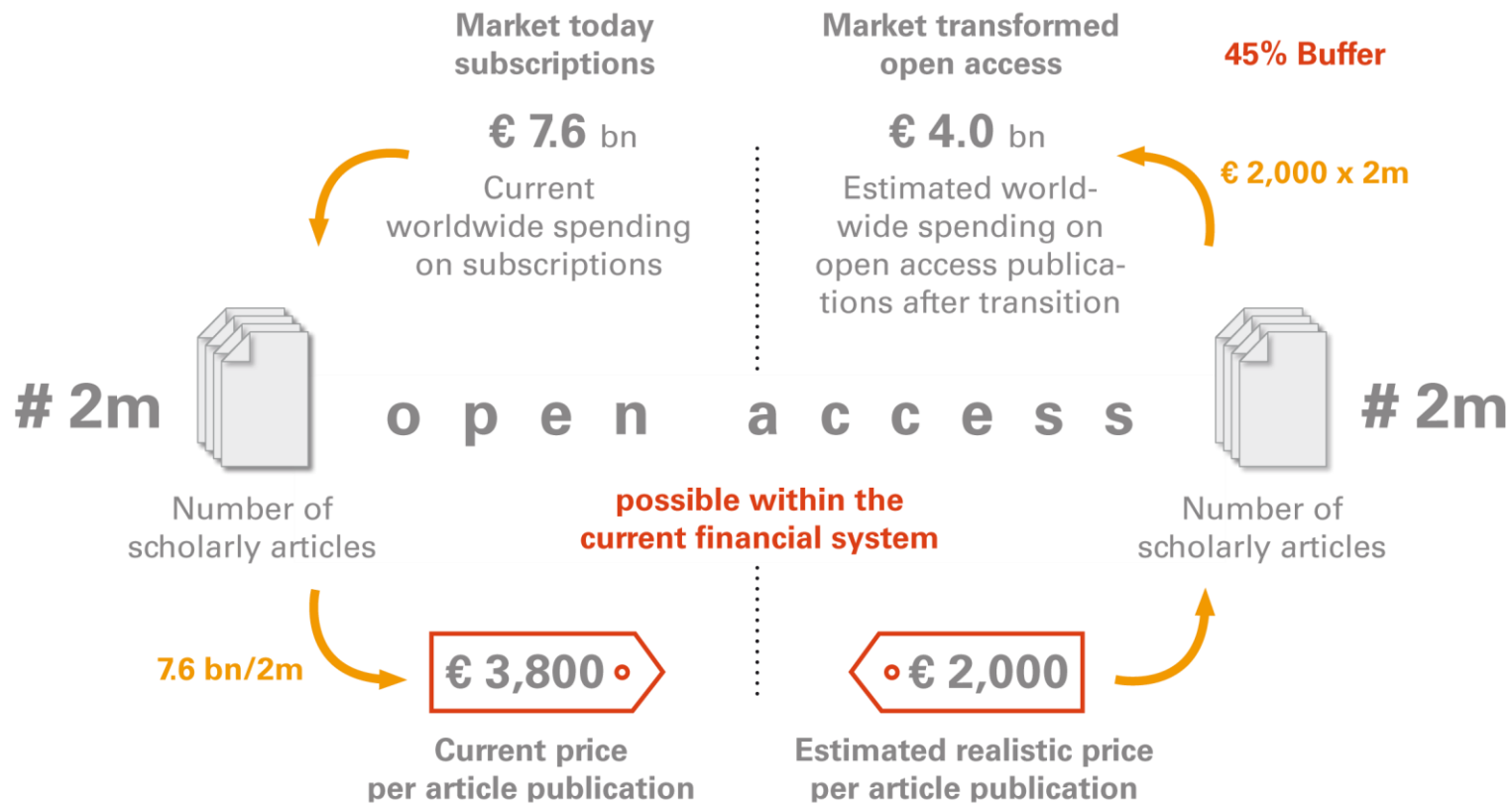

## Worldwide Publishing Market





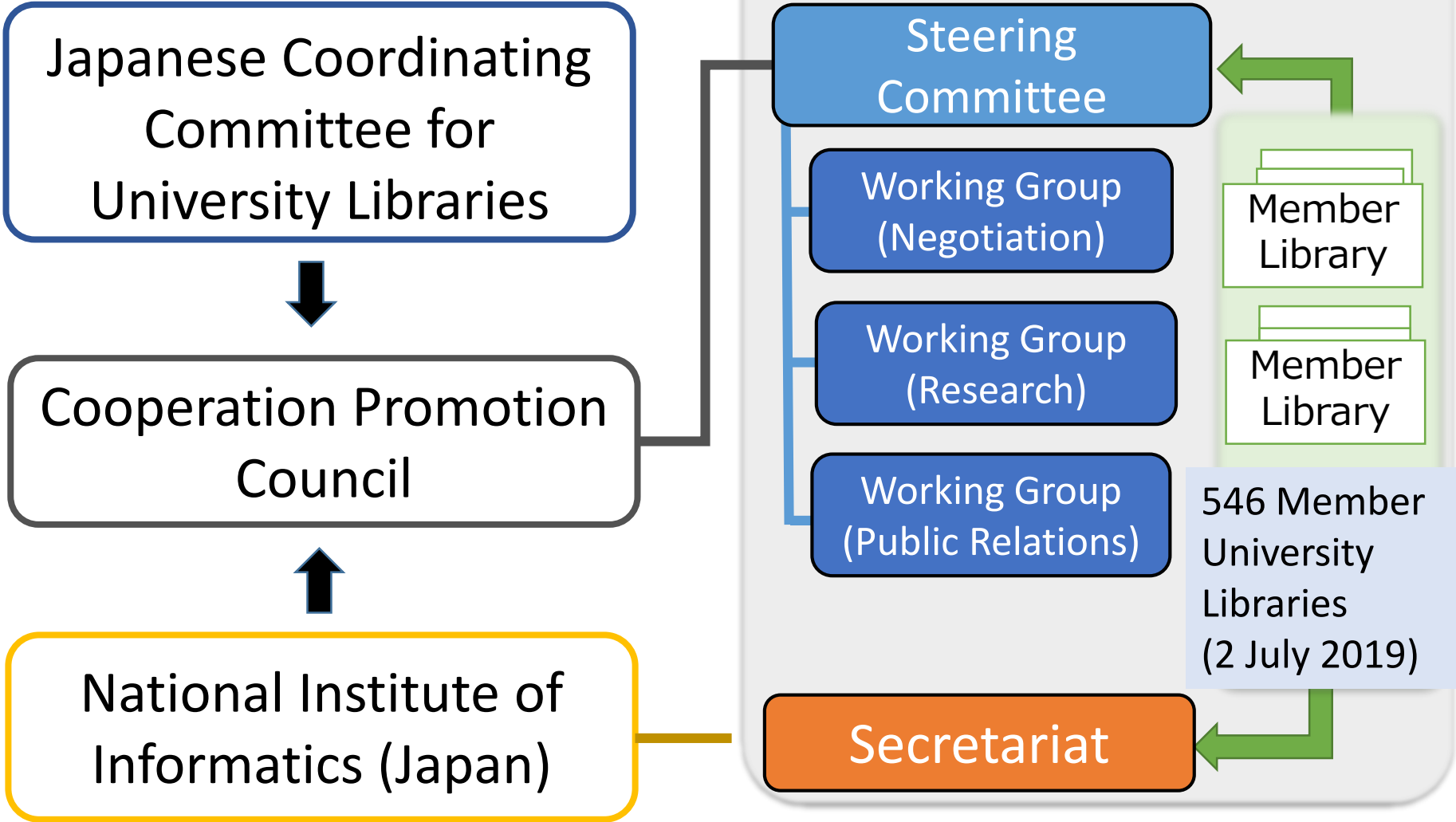

# Organization of JUSTICE



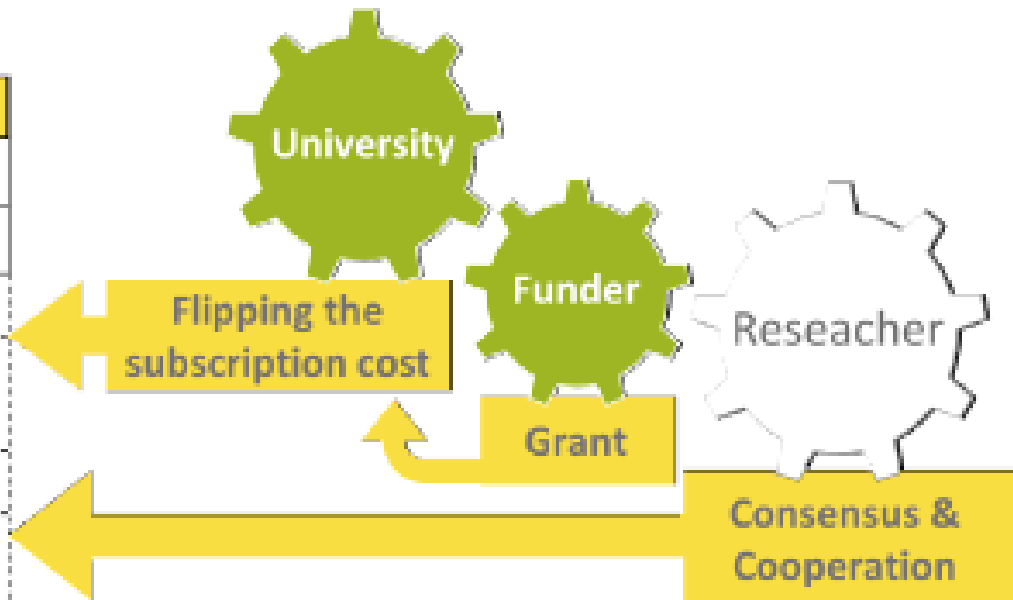
